What is the 100 Club of Arizona?

Who We Help

Arizona certified municipal, county, tribal, and state law enforcement officers; Arizona certified correctional, probation, and parole officers; firefighters; federal law enforcement officers working in the state of Arizona; and military personnel called to active duty while employed by a public safety agency as an officer or firefighter.



The drive into the property took us along a winding, unmarked dirt road through unspoiled desert. This area will eventually be home to upscale residential properties.

Cart paths lead to finely sculpted tee areas that play over landscaped desert, arroyos and washes to generous fairways. There are frequent carries off the tee, but most are reasonable in length. There are 5 sets of tees that play to distances and slopes.

In appearance, this course looks extremely manageable - and the wide fairways plus desert mountain scenery certainly make for a pleasant experience for all levels of golfers. Subtle slopes and design techniques will also make this a challenge that avid players will not forget.
